<p>I here by agree to be bound by the Code of Ethics of Engineers Australia and in doing so I am committing to the Cardinal Principles of the Code of Ethics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To respect the inherent dignity of the individual</li><li>• To act on the basis of well informed conscience</li><li>• To act in the interests of the community</li><li>• To uphold its Tenets</li></ul> <p>The Tenets of the Code of Ethics are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Members shall place their responsibility for the welfare, health and safety of the community before their responsibility to sectional or private interests, or to other members</li><li>2. Members shall act with honour, integrity and dignity in order to merit the trust of the community and the profession</li><li>3. Members shall act only in areas of their competence and in a careful and diligent manner</li><li>4. Members shall act with honesty, good faith and equity and without discrimination towards all in the community</li><li>5. Members shall apply their skill and knowledge in the interest of their employer or client for whom they shall act with integrity without compromising any other obligations to these Tenets</li><li>6. Members shall, where relevant, take reasonable steps to inform themselves, their clients and employers, of the social, environmental, economic and other possible consequences which may arise from their actions</li><li>7. Members shall express opinions, make statements or give evidence with fairness and honesty and only on the basis of adequate knowledge</li><li>8. Members shall continue to develop relevant knowledge, skill and expertise throughout their careers and shall actively assist and encourage those with whom they are associated, to do likewise</li><li>9. Members shall not assist in or induce a breach of these Tenets and shall support those who seek to uphold them if called if called upon or in a position to do so.</li></ol>
