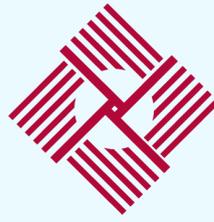

## Asset Management Mentoring Program

A pilot mentor program for the Women In Transport Asset Management Mentoring Program is to be conducted in the coming months. The purpose of the mentor program is to assist in increasing the number of women working in the transport industry, as well as better retain those already in it.

### WHO CAN APPLY?

To join as a mentee, you must be a woman who works in the asset management technical space within the transport portfolio (TFV) Victoria. To join as a mentor, you must have a minimum of five years of technical experience within asset management.

### EXPRESS YOUR INTEREST TODAY

Express your interest today for the pilot program. As applicants will be from different locations, you must be prepared to enter into a mentoring relationship by telephone, email, Skype and other forms of communication.
