## AUCKLAND COUNCIL'S ASSET INFORMATION SYSTEM ENHANCEMENT

Community Facilities (CF) was established in November 2015 after consolidating several asset management functions across Auckland Council, responsible for an asset portfolio of \$11 billion, made up of over 4,000 parks (500,000 ha) and 3,000 buildings (400,000 m2).

The CF Asset Management Enhancement Project (CFAME) was initiated in 2016 to speed up the availability of vital information for decision making and support asset management using the latest technologies and advanced analytics.

Informed by the Asset Information Strategy, CFAME success was attributed to a holistic and structured approach to input-analysis-output of raw data, converting it to information, then knowledge and finally intelligence.
