## INFRASTRUCTURE NSW'S GOVERNMENT ASSET MANAGEMENT POLICY

This session will outline the whole of NSW Government approach, as led by Infrastructure NSW, to develop a new modern NSW Asset Management Framework that is focused on improving the asset management capability and accountability of the NSW public sector.

This approach was in response to the anticipated challenges of population growth, climate change, expectations of level of service offered by infrastructure and the age profile of assets as outlined in the NSW State Infrastructure Strategy 2018-2038. A strong asset management framework is critical to extract maximum benefit from the NSW asset portfolio and to ensure that infrastructure spending remains sustainable to meet future service demand.

A NSW Government Asset Management Policy is the first step to ensure that the management and use of the State's assets must become smarter, more productive and efficient to manage the upward pressure on maintenance requirements and expenditure.
